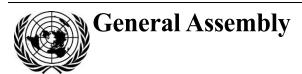

Countering the use of information and communications technologies for criminal purposes

United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland: draft decision*

Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 74/247 of 27 December 2019, in which it decided that the Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes should convene a three-day organizational session in August 2020, in New York, in order to agree on an outline and modalities for its further activities, to be submitted to the General Assembly at its seventy-fifth session for its consideration and approval,

Recalling also its decision 74/567 of 14 August 2020, by which it postponed the organizational session of the Ad Hoc Committee mandated by paragraph 3 of resolution 74/247 to a date as early as conditions permit but not later than 1 March 2021,

Noting with concern the ongoing situation concerning the coronavirus disease (COVID-19),

- (a) Decides to further postpone the organizational session of the Ad Hoc Committee mandated by paragraph 3 of resolution 74/247 to a date as early as conditions permit but not later than 31 May 2021;
- (b) Confirms that the report of the organizational session of the Ad Hoc Committee, including the agreed outline and modalities for the further activities of the Committee, and any budgetary implications, shall be submitted to the General Assembly at its seventy-fifth session for its consideration and approval.
